KATA RULES

KA1, KA2,

Kihon Kata and Pinan Kata (Or Equivalent) only, NO Advanced Kata. May repeat the same Kata.
Competitors may enter the next category up if they wish to compete using advanced Kata.

KA4, KA5, KA7, KA9, KA10, KA13, KA15, KA17

Kihon Kata and Pinan Kata (Or Equivalent) only, NO Advanced Kata. May repeat the same Kata but NOT consecutively (i.e. Minimum of two Kata needed).

Competitors may enter the next category up if they wish to compete using advanced Kata.

KA3, KA6, KA8, KA11, KA12, KA14, KA16, KA18

First round* MUST be a Pinan Kata (Or Equivalent). Then free choice but cannot repeat a Kata.

*First Round is defined as the first round that ALL competitors are in, so if some competitors are in a preliminary round (i.e. not seeded) they may have to perform a Pinan Kata twice.

KICK MASTER KUMITE

Consists of each competitor simultaneously attacking their respective red or blue kick post for 30 seconds. The competitor who is judged to have attacked with the most skill will be awarded the win. 3 Flags used as in Kata.

The entry fee for Kick Master Kumite will be donated to Comic/Sport Relief

Under – subscribed categories may be merged with another or cancelled without prior notice at the discretion of the event organiser.

KUMITE RULES - IMPORTANT

ALL CATEGORIES

WKF Rules 7.0 (January 2012) will be in effect on all areas with *some* possible amendments at the discretion of the Chief Referee.

- No Sai Shiai in ANY categories, Referee/Judge (Hantei) decision in individual matches.
- In team matches a deciding bout will be held when both teams have equal wins & points, Hantei in the event of the deciding bout being a draw.
- Points
 - 1 Point – Yuko (Chudan or Jodan Tsuki/Uchi)
 - 2 Points – Waza-ari (Chudan Kicks)
 - 3 Points – Ippon (Jodan Kicks, Any scoring technique delivered on a thrown/fallen opponent)

KU2, KU3

No contact to the face/head/neck with ANY techniques, up to 10cm scoring distance from the face/head. Win by getting 6 points clear. 1 min duration. No sweeps or takedowns are to be attempted.

KU4, KU5, KU6, KU7

No contact to the face/head/neck with ANY techniques, up to 10cm scoring distance from the face/head. Win by getting 8 points clear. 1.5 min duration.

KU8, KU9, KU10, KU11, KU22, KU23

Very light 'skin touch' to the face/head/neck (including face mask where applicable), up to 10cm scoring distance from the face/head. Light 'skin touch' with kicking techniques. Win by getting 8 points clear, 1.5 min duration.

KU12, KU13, KU14, KU15, KU24, KU25

WKF Junior Rules, 10cm scoring distance from the face/head, Win by getting 8 points clear, 1.5 min duration.

KU16, KU17, KU18, KU19, KU20, KU21, KU26, KU27

WKF Rules, Light 'skin touch' with punches & kicks and up to 5cm scoring distance. Win by getting 8 points clear, 1.5 min duration.

ESSENTIAL EQUIPMENT

Gum Shield	Must be worn in all Kumite bouts & fit correctly
Hand Mitts	Must be worn in all Kumite bouts, WKF style (they don't have to have the WKF stamp on them), red or blue only.
Shin pads	WKF style shin OR WKF style shin & removable foot, red or blue only COMPULSORY for +14 years
Chest / Groin guard	WKF approved guards MAY be worn
Girls Hair	Must be tied back with no distracting features
Hair Clips	NO METAL hair clips may be worn in ANY events (This INCLUDES all Kata events!)
Karate Suit	White only, sleeves MUST NOT be rolled up

Hartlepool Wadokai have a limited number of Hand Mitts & Shin Pads for students to use during the day but competitors are encouraged to bring their own (Make sure your name is written on!)

Red and Blue belts will be provided but competitors are encouraged to use their own if they have them.

Basic equipment (Suits, Gloves, Gum Shields) will be available to purchase at the event.

ALL CLUBS MUST NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

This competition is open to any club or association in compliance with the rules and regulations of World Karate Federation. Any club / association not in direct membership to the EKF or equivalent must declare to the effect that they do not belong to an opposing world body in contravention of WKF statute 21.9.
